Business Case Development – Training Session

NSW Environment Protection Authority and Marsden Jacob Associates are running a business case development training session for potential applicants under the Waste Less, Recycle More funding initiative. The training will help potential applicants to understand the requirements and expectations of funding business cases. The training session will be presented by Sian McGhie and Mark Jackson (NSW Environment Protection Authority) and Rod Carr (Marsden Jacob Associates).

The NSW Government wants high quality funding business cases that demonstrate a detailed assessment of the following

- Market viability
- Technical suitability and viability
- NSW Treasury compliant cost-benefit (economic) and financial analysis
- Required approvals, licensing and best practice
- Project impacts – environmental, social and economic
- Project management – demonstrated ability to deliver the project to a high standard

The NSW Environment Protection Authority and Marsden Jacob Associates will be tailoring the training session to address participants' specific requirements. Prior to the information session a brief questionnaire will be emailed to participants seeking input on priorities for the training session. Given the considerable number of questions that have already been received on the economic and financial viability analysis, the training session will include a specific session on these requirements and tools that have been developed to support funding applicants.

Waste Less, Recycle More is the largest waste and recycling funding initiative in Australia: a five-year \$465.7 million program to transform waste and recycling in NSW. Funding programs under the initiative are designed to stimulate new investment in innovative approaches to improve the way that we view and manage waste across NSW.
